Please be aware that our texting system alerts the primary contact only, if someone else is responsible for your child when a message is sent, please make sure that the text message is passed on.

We would like to send as much information as possible via email, so would be grateful if you could let us know that you are happy to receive information using this method - if you are, please make sure we have your email address. All information will be treated in confidence.

The next few weeks are quite busy starting this week with the **photographer** coming tomorrow on **Tues 22nd** to take our individual children and sibling photographs. These make delightful reminders but please be assured that there is absolutely no pressure to buy any of the photos.

My Headteacher '**Drop in Surgery**' is this **Wed 23rd** between **5.30-7pm**. These sessions are meant as an opportunity for anyone to raise any concerns, ask advice and/or find out more about what is happening in school. Whilst an appointment is not necessary, it is helpful if you can let the office know you are coming. Dates for the rest of this term are detailed overleaf.

Our **Y5/6 football team** are taking part in a tournament at the Madjeski Dome this **Fri 25th** as well as a league match on **Fri 2nd Oct** after school at **Highwood**. For our Harvest this year we will be supporting the Woodley Food Bank. Donations of tea, coffee (instant), sugar, cereals, jams, tinned meat, tinned fish, tinned fruits, tinned vegetables, tinned soups, rice, biscuits, and chocolate would be greatly appreciated. Contributions can be brought in from **Mon 28th** for EYFS & KS1 children. We would also be delighted if you could join us for our **Junior Harvest Service** which will take place at **St John's Church** on **Fri 2nd Oct** from **9am** (ish). Junior children should arrive at St John's church between **8.40 - 8.50am** with their Harvest donations. If your child has a packed lunch you may prefer to drop that off at school first. If your child has a school dinner please order and pay for that beforehand - ideally at the beginning of the week. Please drop infant siblings at school first. If you would find it difficult to deliver your child to St John's Church please let your child's teacher know as soon as possible. We will be walking the children back to school following the service - any offers of help would be greatly appreciated.

Another fast approaching 'event' where we hope you will be able to join us, as well as put forward your ideas to make our fundraising even more successful, is the **PTA AGM at 8pm** on **Thurs 1st Oct** in **Maple** - I hope to see you there.

Family Fridays for **KS1** will start on **Fri 2nd Oct** and for **KS2** the **following week** - contrary to rumours that have circulated in the past (started we believe by some of our junior children) Family Fridays **do** continue in the juniors.

And Finally ... we are introducing a bell at 8.40am as the signal that children should come into school; by the time the second bell rings at 8.50am children should be in the classroom ready for registration.
