Dear Parents/Carers,

COVID-19

Thank you for your support helping to keep the number of cases with COVID-19 down within the school. Currently, it is UKS2 with the most cases and as a precautionary measure, the children are being taught in class groups. We all need to be vigilant. Keep testing and follow our guidance. If you unsure if your child has symptoms or is a close contact please do not hesitate to call the school office.

Attendance

As per our Attendance Policy, please make sure that if your child is absent from school that you phone the absence line before 9.30am to report your child's absence. This must be done on the first day and any subsequent day of absence. The school has a safeguarding responsibility to check on the absence of all children. Please help us to do this by phoning before 9.30am. The school office is making too many calls to parents to find out why children are absent from school. Failure to contact the school could lead to a home visit as part of our safeguarding procedures

We have an increasing number of children who are arriving late to school. Please ensure your child arrives punctually and prepared for the school day. Children are able to enter school from 8.40am and should be in school before the gates close at 8.50am.

Nativity and FS2 Tableau

Each school will carry out a risk assessment about the suitability of inviting parents and visitors into school. As we are in the COVID category of "Contingency" which means we have had an increased number of cases in school, we have decided to film our KS1 Nativity and FS2 Tableau and send this to parents. I know this is extremely disappointing but the first priority has to be to keep the school community safe.

School Uniform

As the weather gets colder and we continue to keep school well ventilated, children may wish to bring an extra layer of clothing to help keep warm. This is in addition to school uniform not instead of school uniform. This should ideally be a dark or plain coloured fleece. Your support with this is greatly appreciated.
