Remember to use a capital<br>letter for their name.  | Create your own Easter egg. Decorate it using a repeated pattern and different 2D shapes. You could use a variety of resources you have at home e.g. pens, pencils, paint or collage.   | Create an invitation for the best Easter party you can imagine. Think about what kind of food you're going to have and games you're going to play.  |  |

For example: Word, Purple Mash or you could use paper.   | Create and set up your own treasure hunt around your home or garden. | I enjoy working with numbers and science  | Play the toy shop money game using this link and select the level of challenge appropriate to you. Select which coins you would use to pay for the toy. | Collect suitable items from around your home and test to see if they float or sink.(Please ask your grown up before you do this challenge). Record your findings. You could record them in a table.         | Research all about rabbits or chicks using kiddle.com. Create a fact file or poster with scientific facts on it such as: habitat, food, predators, animal type etc.                           |  |
| I enjoy painting, drawing and visualising   | Design and make your own Easter paper chains and decorate your bedroom with them.   | Go outside into your garden to look for the signs of Spring or watch the following video for inspiration. Create a picture of your favourite thing about Spring. You could draw, paint or create a collage. | Create a self-portrait (or any other picture!) using only natural objects from your garden. You could use grass, gravel, stones, leaves, flowers or anything else that you can find!          |  |
| I enjoy doing hands-on activities   | Take part in the Easter Go-Noodle video. Click here for the link  | Go on a bug hunt around your garden or on your daily walk. Record which insects you find. You could draw pictures or take photos too.   | Use the seeds of a fruit (e.g. apple, pear, tomato, strawberry) and see if you can get it to grow! Think about the best place to plant it, e.g. in the sunlight and don't forget to water it! |  |
