Punctuation

- **Full stop:** marks the end of a sentence.
- **Apostrophe:** shows belonging or missing letters eg. can't and couldn't.
- **Colon:** joins two related clauses, where one cannot stand alone.
- **Semicolon:** joins two clauses that are related but can stand alone as well.
- **Question mark:** shows that a question is being asked.
- **Inverted commas:** When a quotation is made.
