Dear Parents/Carers,

COVID-19 - Localised Guidance from Wokingham Borough Council

From Monday 4th October, if you have children that are taking a PCR test, they should remain absent from school until they have a negative result. If a pupil tests positive, they should continue to self-isolate in line with Public Health guidance. For pupils with a sibling that tests positive, regardless of the school they attend, they should also self-isolate until undertaking a PCR test on day 3 to 5. They can then return to school if the PCR test is negative.

Absences

If your child is absent from school please phone the office and leave a message stating the reason for absence on the absent answer phone before 9.30am. It is important that your child's absence is recorded correctly. Please phone on the first day of absence and any subsequent days.

Airfield Breakfast Club

After surveying all parents, we not be able to open the breakfast club due to the low numbers of confirmed bookings as it is not financially viable for the school.

Currently the After school club is not breaking even so we continue to review it on a regular basis. The school does not receive any financial support or grant funding to run wrap around care and we not able to support its costs from the main school budget, therefore, Airfield club must be funded from the fees paid by parents.

Since COVID, the number of required places has reduced significantly and whilst we take into consideration parents' working patterns, we are only able to run these clubs with confirmed bookings that cover all costs of the club.
