Dear Parents/Carers,

Parents Evening

Due to current COVID-19 restrictions, we have made the decision to complete our parents evening online again this term. We hope to be able to provide time at a later date for parents to view their child's work in person.

School Disco

Due to current COVID-19 restrictions the PTA disco planned for Friday 19th November will be postponed until further notice.

Currently Lower Junior and Upper Junior children are not mixing which would have made the junior disco very difficult to organise.

E-Scooters

We have been asked by Wokingham Local Authority to talk to our parents and pupils about the use of E-Scooters by pupils travelling to and from school. We no longer can permit E-Scooters being left anywhere on our site. Please read the attached PDF and statement from Wokingham LA:

Did you know it's illegal to ride a privately owned electric scooter (e-scooter) in public?

You cannot use a privately owned e-scooter on the road, pavement or in a public space. If you do then you risk receiving a large fine, points on your driving licence and your e-scooter could be seized. Privately owned escooters can only be used on private land, with the permission of the landowner. This is because e-scooters are classed as motor vehicles in law. So, in theory, this means that you need an MOT, road tax and insurance to use one, however it isn't currently possible to register escooters in this way.

Water Bottles

We still have a large number of children who do not bring a water bottle to school. It is important that children stay hydrated throughout the day. Please make sure a bottle is brought into school everyday.

Cross Country

Unfortunately, due to raising cases of COVID-19 within the Wokingham Borough, the cross country league has been cancelled for this year.

Remembrance and Poppy Appeal

Our children will be celebrating Remembrance Day next week. We will be discussing our associated Core Value 'Peace' and remembering all of those who have suffered serving in the armed forces.
