Upload a photo to E-Schools	Research the statues on Easter Island (Moai) and then create a model of one using a medium of your choice. There is a book in Epic Books which may help – 'Mysteries of Easter Island'
I enjoy doing hands-on activities	Create a 3-5 minute workout video (Joe Wicks style for example) for people to do at home with their families?	Create a video diary updating your teacher on what you have been up to at home e.g. things you've made, how you've been keeping busy, etc.	Make a salt dough ornament, fossil or animal upload finished piece on E-Schools
I enjoy listening and making music	Listen to ' Spring Chicken '. Perform it for/with your family. Video it if everyone agrees.	Create a project on Scratch, using 'Music' blocks to celebrate Easter.
